Harbour master and coastguard

The Harbour Master and Coastguard are located at the Harbour Master's Office, at the SW end of the harbour.

Weather forecasts and reports are available at the Harbour Master's Office or on VHF from Alderney Coastguard, which can also supply a Radar VTS and RDF service.

The Harbour Master's office provides a Coastguard Service, telephone 01481 822620.

VHF radio

Call 'Alderney Coastguard', VHF 16, 74 and 67. The Harbour launch also listens on Ch.74, call 'Harbour Launch'. If not obtainable, for emergencies only, call Guernsey Coastguard (Ch.16,20) or Jersey Coastguard (Ch.16,82).

Anchorage and mooring

There are 70 yellow visitors' mooring buoys, and it is possible to raft up on these in good weather. Mooring fees are £15 per day for a mooring and £5 per day for anchorage. **All other mooring buoys are private and should not be used without permission.**

The anchorage in the middle of the bay has good holding ground in sand, but there are areas of rock and weed. Towards the entrance of the harbour, the bottom is generally more rocky.

Because of the tidal range at Springs (up to 6.9m), a good scope of anchor line should be used, especially if anchoring in shoal areas. It is not permitted to anchor in the Fairway or close to Braye Jetty, or to tie up to Braye Jetty without permission.

Regulations

There is a speed limit of 4 knots in the harbour, Saye, Corblets and Longis bays. It is not permitted to tie up to the Commercial Quay, or the Breakwater, nor beach on Braye or Saye bays. For Customs clearance, Braye is the only port of entry. All vessels entering from outside the Bailiwick of Guernsey must complete a customs form, supplied by the Harbour Launch or obtained from the Harbour Master's Office – UK forms are not valid. Customs must be notified of any animals onboard – UK rules apply.

Animals may not be landed ashore until Customs clearance has been obtained.

indicates depth of water alongside. Mainbrayce
is open (during season 08:00-18:00 seven days
a week) other months according to demand,
providing a wide range of services – fuel, water,
general chandlery, marine engineering, water
taxi, tig welding and euro exchange. Local
advice and information also available.

Les Etacs Gannet Colony

Often teeming with over 11,000 birds, Les Etacs is a spectacular example as to why Alderney is a designated Ramsar site (a wetland of national importance).

Best visited by boat, but easily viewed from the southern cliffs.

Take the scenic route with Walking Guide 2 'Gannet Trail'. Boat tours available with Lady Maris II, Sula of Bray and Voyager.

Vau de Saou and Wildlife Bunker

This steep-sided wooded valley with bluebells in spring is bursting with wildlife. Nearby is a converted WWII bunker displaying information on the island's natural and military history.

Use Walking Guide 1 'Southern Cliffs and Wildlife Bunker' to explore this rewarding area. Open all year.

St Anne's Church

Known as 'The Cathedral of the Channel Islands', St Anne's Church is steeped in history, having played many roles throughout Alderney's past. Situated in beautiful surroundings and accessible from Victoria Street, this stunning church, now with a tower of 12 bells is well worth a visit.

Use Walking Guide 8 'St Anne Town Walk' to learn more about the history of St Anne.

The Nunnery

This Roman fort epitomises the way that strategically important positions on Alderney have been adopted and reused during each wave of fortifications on the island.

There is no official access to the interior of the Nunnery, however, much of the site can be seen from the exterior.

The Odeon

This huge concrete MP3 naval range finding tower offers spectacular views and a glimpse into Alderney's past.

Bibette Head

Take a torch and visit Bibette Head, Strongpoint Biberkopt, the site of some of the most interesting and best preserved German defences in Alderney and the Channel Islands. With its intact trenches, tunnel, armoured machine gun cupola and casemated gun positions, this site offers a remarkable insight into the fortification of the island. Open all year.

Cambridge Battery

Following extensive clearance and conservation work, part of the northern defences of Fort Tourgis is open to the public. Cambridge Battery is an excellent example of how the original Victorian fortifications were adapted by the German forces during WWII. An information board in the searchlight position gives a fascinating panoramic detail of the surrounding Ramsar site.

Use Walking Guide 4 'Burhou and Fort Clonque' to discover the surrounding area. Open all year.

There are so many ways to explore Alderney; take time to roam and discover just what makes it so special. Wander the numerous paths, lanes and tracks, and uncover the island's fascinating history and precious wildlife along the way. Our island is yours to enjoy.

One of the best ways to see Alderney is on foot. There's nothing quite like the feeling of setting out on a bright morning to explore the island, armed with maps for one or two of the eight special walks. It's very difficult to get lost here and there's always a friendly islander to point you in the right direction. The island's size means that you can meander along the coast path in a day, which is a great way to enjoy magnificent views and fresh air.

If you prefer a gentler stroll there are plenty of well-placed seats around the coast. Our favourites include Corblets, a good place to watch the surfers; the hidden bench at Bibette Head with views across to the harbour; and the seat overlooking Les Etacs gannet colony, for one of the best views on the island.

Many visitors hire bicycles. Alderney's roads are quiet and the speed limit is low. Cycling gives you easy access to some of the tracks and pathways that open up to reveal stunning views, such as the panorama from Fort Albert, the plunging cliffs toward Telegraph Bay or the fort covered coast between the lighthouse and Longis Bay.

If you wish to dig a little deeper you can discover Alderney through some of our many tours. From minibus tours and guided walks to round island boat trips and hedgehog walks, you'll find our local guides' knowledge and enthusiasm infectious.

MOBILE PHONES

Certain mobile networks require a roaming facility plus international dialling code. Please check with your provider.

PASSPORTS

Passports are not required for citizens of Britain and the Irish Republic, however, photographic ID is required for travel to Alderney (e.g. driver's licence or passport). Visitors from EU countries need valid passports or national identity cards. Nationals of other Western European countries and North America require valid passports, but not visas. However, if you plan to visit France during your stay in Alderney, you will need your passport.

TIME ZONE

Same as Great Britain (GMT).

CLIMATE

Mild. Nearly 2,000 hours of sunshine per year. Summer temperatures average between 20°C-24°C and between 17°C-20°C in spring and autumn. Frost and snow are extremely rare.

PUBLIC HOLIDAYS

Same as Great Britain, except for August Bank Holiday which in Alderney is on the first Monday of August when the island celebrates Cavalcade Day, and 15 December "Homecoming Day" which celebrates the islanders' return in 1945, after the mass evacuation in June 1940.

TRAVELLING WITH YOUR PET

Alderney is rabies-free and some hotels, guest houses and self-catering establishments on the island welcome pets. However, please note only dogs* originating from the British Isles or legally imported into the UK may be landed in Alderney once they have been cleared by Alderney's Customs Authorities. Please refer to section 'Regulations' on page 3.

Under the Pet Travel Scheme, cats and dogs may also be imported from St. Malo, via Guernsey or Jersey, with Condor Ferries. Otherwise a 6-month quarantine applies. For details and conditions please contact the respective airline or ferry company prior to making any travel arrangements.

***Please note:** Pit Bull Terriers, Japanese Tosa or any other type of dog which appears to have been bred for fighting may not be imported. For details, conditions and exceptions regarding the Pet Travel Scheme and any queries relating to the importation of animals, please contact the Commerce and Employment Department directly before making any arrangements: 01481 234567.

Healthcare

IMPORTANT NOTE

There is currently no reciprocal health care agreement between the UK Department of Health and the Channel Islands.

Healthcare in Alderney is provided by the Health and Social Services Department and is outside the UK National Health Service. The European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) is not valid in the Bailiwick of Guernsey (Guernsey, Alderney, Sark & Herm).
