

Alderney has 10 miles of stunning coast path with many historic fortifications from Roman to WW2. Spot the unique wildlife in the air, on the land and in the sea.

The coast path is way-marked with information on distance to Braye from either direction of travel. Each sign is numbered to correspond with the map overleaf.

There is a letter on each sign. These join up to make the names of some of Alderney's iconic species of flora and fauna. Make a note of each letter in the table below to enter our challenge.



We challenge you to walk or run the whole route.

Start where you like, either direction, take as many days as you want then bring this completed form to the Tourist Information Centre in Victoria Street or to the Braye Beach Hotel to claim a certificate that you have walked or run the whole 10 miles of coast path.

There are **toilets** in Braye and between markers 17 & 18 and near marker 30 (Campsite).

Food / drink outlets in Braye and near marker 17 (Old Barn) and near marker 30 (Campsite).

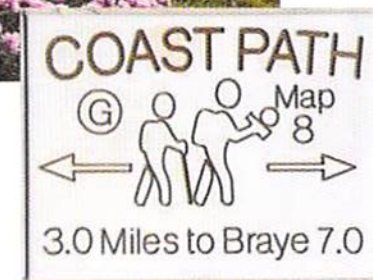

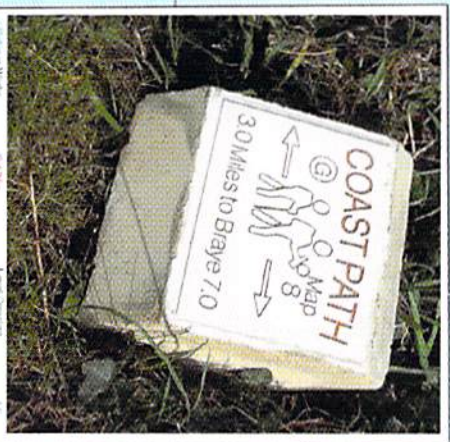
